



Speaker Series / Dr. Petr Jansa, Ph.D



This year the ability to pivot has enabled organizations to continue fulfilling their missions and engage the community and Sokol SF is no exception. Because our ability to gather in person is limited, on September 9th, **Sokol SF launched a virtual speaker series**with a presentation by Petr Jansa, PhD, about a timely topic on everyone's mind - COVID-19. Dr. Jansa spent an hour discussing the disease, its transmission, his work on developing anti-viral drugs, including Remdesivir, and ways to protect yourself, while answering questions from the approximate 43 attendees who were present via Zoom. The presentation was a fascinating dive into some of the details about the history of coronaviruses, how they spread, current therapies and the ways we can defeat the virus. Lake Chabot Hike Recap



Recipe for Creamy Mushroom Soup

Oct 8th / 8. říjen Sokol Memorial Day (Památný den Sokolstva)

V roce 2019 byl Vládou České republiky 8. říjen schválen Významným dnem České republiky jako Památný den sokolstva.

Památný den sokolstva je poctou všem členům a členkám Sokola, kteří během téměř 160 let existence našeho spolku obětovali své životy v boji za svobodu, demokracii a samostatnost. Od roku 2019 je zařazen do kalendáře významných dnů České republiky.

Nacistická "Akce Sokol"

Datum 8. října bylo zvoleno jako připomínka tragických událostí roku 1941. V noci ze 7. na 8. října 1941 gestapo v rámci "Akce Sokol" zatklo na 1500 sokolských činovníků z ústředí, žup i větších jednot. Byli mučeni, vězněni, deportováni do koncentračních táborů. Plných 93 % z nich do konce války zahynulo. Ještě během této noci podepsal Reinhard Heydrich úřední výměr o rozpuštění České obce sokolské, kterou nacisté považovali za nejnebezpečnější domácí organizaci. Nejvýznamnějším skutkem sokolského odboje se pak stala spolupráce při atentátu na Reinharda Heydricha, který by se bez doslova sebevražedné pomoci sokolů nemohl nikdy uskutečnit.

Pietní akty {Večer sokolských světel}

Po celý den 8. října se v místech, kde působí sokolské jednoty, konají různé pietní akty a společenská setkání. Celý den zakončuje Večer sokolských světel. Tradiční sokolská vzpomínková akce má svíčkami puštěnými po vodní hladině připomenout osud konkrétního sokolského hrdiny, který obětoval život pro svou vlast.



In Remembrance Ludwig Mlynek



Ludwig Mlynek March 21, 1936 - Sept 16, 2020

Ludwig Mlynek passed away peacefully at the age of 84, with his wife and both of his sons at his side, succumbing to complications from longterm kidney failure. Born in Holesov, Czechoslovakia, graduated from business school in Zlin and the University of Economics in Prague. In 1976, Ludwig, his wife, and their two sons escaped from Czechoslovakia through Austria to the US. Ludwig led a full life, and had a very successful 24-year career in Bank of America. He was a long-time member of Sokol SF and will be missed by all. Due to current COVID-19 restrictions, a celebration of his life will take place next year, with the date to be announced


