Gratias Agit Award Recipient Jara Dusatko, President Sokol SF



Since 1997, the Czech Minister of Foreign Affairs has awarded the prestigious Gratias Agit award to prominent personalities and nongovernment organizations for the promotion of the good name of the Czech Republic around the world.

For those who know Jara Dusatko, it should come as no surprise that she was one of 2020's recipients of the award. Since 2009, Jara has served as Sokol SF's president and has whole-heartedly dedicated herself to carrying out the mission of organization. She has spent tireless hours organizing cultural, social and physical fitness events and activities that foster the community and celebrate our heritage, and serves as a role-model to us all about the impact voluntary work can make on

other individuals. Richard Pivnicka, the Honorary Consul General of San Francisco/Silicon Valley, commented that he was pleased the Czech government had recognized a lifetime of work, which couldn't have gone to a more worthy recipient. And as if that weren't enough, since 1997 she has also been a lecturer of the Czech language at Stanford University and more recently taught Czech at the Czech School of California.

As a recipient of the award, Jara was in good company, as fellow recipients this year included singer Joan Baez of Woodside, CA, Polish publisher and the head of Czechoslovak-Polish Solidarity, Julian Kazimierz Golak of Poland and Margita Štěrbová, a mountaineer and humanitarian worker who resides in Pakiistan. <u>View a brochure of all recipients.</u>

Hometown of Olympic Gold Medalist Emil Zátopek to immortalize him in bronze

The northern Moravian town of Kopřivnice this weekend officially launched a public

collection to fund a statue of favourite son Emil Zátopek – arguably the greatest distance runner in history – in time for the 100th anniversary of his birth next September. Emil Zátopek is the only runner in history to have won the 5,000 metre, 10,000 metre and Marathon races in the same Olympic Games. Remarkably, after winning gold in those first two events in Helsinki in 1952, Zátopek decided at the last minute to run the marathon – his first.

Remembering Jiří Menzel 2.23.38 - 9.5.20



The Oscar-winning Czech film director Jiří Menzel has died at the age of 82 after a long illness. His wife Olga Menzelová posted the news on Facebook late on Sunday.

Menzel won an Academy Award for Best Foreign Language Film in 1967 for "Closely Watched Trains," a World War II drama based on a novel by the Czech writer Bohumil Hrabal.

Born on 23 February 1938, Menzel studied film direction at Prague's Film and TV School of Performing Arts FAMU. In the 1960s he became one of the leading figures of the Czech New Wave, alongside directors such as Miloš Forman or Věra Chytilová.

His collaboration with Hrabal, which included "Cutting It Short" and "Larks on a String" proved to be one of the major hallmarks of his career. The latter, considered by many his masterpiece, was banned by the Communists and only released after the fall of communism in 1989. Menzel, who continued to make films into the new millennium, won a number of awards, including a Czech Lion for lifetime artistic contribution and a Medal of Merit, the French Order of Arts and Literature.
